Sounds like you are restricting your voice a bit in take 1; would love to hear your full chest voice, instead of the softer/breathier read. 2nd take--be careful--can you sustain this voice throughout a 4-hour session healthily? Doesn't sound like it would be comfortable for you to do that for a full session. Want to always be sure that if you're submitting a character or creature voice for an audition, that you can sustain it and be consistent throughout, without hurting yourself.
