Jersey Mike's was a tough one because it was very wordy for a :15 and for the original audition, they were okay with people going slightly over as long as it sounded like a conversational pacing. If that ever happens to you where it's a lot of words for a short length, feel free to ask your agent if you should A) rush the read to fit the :15 or B) take more time so you can add your personality to it so it doesn't feel rushed. Most of the time when this happens, we tell our actors to take more time with it (not to the point where it's too drawn out - should still be on the quicker side) to allow your personality to be in there.</p>

For your 2nd take, the 3rd to last line was written as "and, of course" and sounds like you added it in for the 2nd to last line as well - try to avoid repetition, especially if it's something your improv-ing.
